Getting Acquainted With the Life Journal

Detailed over the next few pages are some easy tips about how to set up your own personal Life Journal, where you will be able to document what you have heard from God and how it will make a difference in your life. The instructions detailed here will work best if you find a diary or a journal that has at least 366 pages plus at least 8 additional pages for the 'contents' and 'prayer request' pages. You may choose to do something "on line". Either way the principles detailed here would still apply.

Table of Contents

The first pages of your journal should be set aside as the 'contents' pages. This will enable you at a later date to easily scan through the contents pages and find that special thing that God spoke to you about. The contents pages should be filled out as per the example below. Make sure you leave enough empty pages at the front of your journal to allow for the daily entries that you will make in this book throughout the year (i.e. 366 entries).

Prayers: Requests and Answers

Title a blank page directly after the 'Contents Section' to create a 'Prayer List'. Here you can record those items, people, and upcoming plans that you are praying for. Enter the date that you began praying for them as well as when God answers it. When you complete one journal, transfer any prayers yet to be answered to your new one. Pray 'PUSH' type prayers - pray Until Something Happens!

Daily Pages

This is where it all happens. The daily pages are where you will make your entries as you follow the Bible reading program found in this Life Journal Reading Plan. You will need to number and date these pages individually as per the example on page 4.

How to Use the Life Journal Reading Plan

We highly recommend that you use the "SOAP" model of journaling as detailed below.

Scripture: Find the Bible reading corresponding to today's date and turn to the chapter. As you read the passages ask the Holy Spirit to teach you and to guide you into all truth. As you read the passages underline or highlight anything that the Lord impresses on your heart.

When you read with an open heart, the Lord will give you words of encouragement, direction and correction.(2 Tim.3: 16) Turn to the next fresh page in the "Daily Pages" section of your journal and write down the scripture that stands out the most to you. (See example on page 4)

Observation: Once God has revealed a special life lesson to you about that scripture, write down some observations about that particular verse and why it stood out to you, and how you might apply it to you life and to the world around you. Also once you have decided what you are going to write about make sure you put a topic at the top of your page and also on your table of contents. (See example on page 4)

Application: This is where you can write down what you have decided to do that is different as a result of the scripture that you have read and the observations that you have made.

Prayer: Finally, record a short prayer to the Lord either asking for help from him to do that which you have committed to do, or for more guidance, etc. Whilst you are praying don't forget to turn to your Prayer List page and to pray for everything outstanding on the list.

Also don't forget to mark off each daily reading in this reading plan as you complete it to keep yourself accountable.

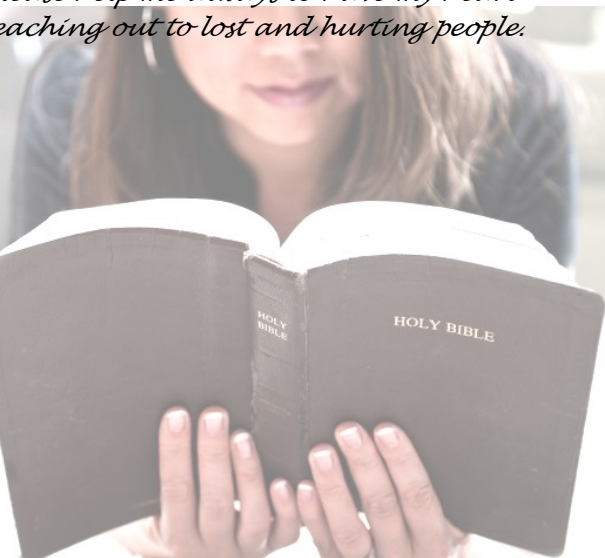
Scripture: *Luke 15:2 But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them."*

Observation: *The Pharisees and the teachers of the law were the only ones who really knew the holy scriptures and they knew them really well. Still they were totally missing God's priorities and heart even though it was right in front of them.*

Application: *Jesus came to seek and to save the lost. As Christians and churches we need to be just as careful to remember that our primary task for Jesus is to reach the lost. Reaching out to them and "making disciples"*

Prayer: *Lord Jesus, please help me always to have my heart aligned with yours—reaching out to lost and hurting people. Amen*
